The Sustainability & Social Immersion Program (SSIP) will consist of two parts:

I - Roundtable@ RISE 2016 – Forum to explore synergies among Swedish Institute Alumni and Swedish companies in India. This will be an opportunity to understand better each other's areas of interest in diversity, inclusion and sustainability as well as share experiences from their line of work and potentially result in long term partnerships and projects.

Roundtable@ RISE 2016

- Topic: Facilitating collaboration between CSR thrust areas for the development of a defined geographic location (we could give this a name!)
 - A presentation on the model (not a ppt ☺) followed by details of the exact location and work to be undertaken (safest option is to pick a potential host in Maharashtra with interventions in child and mother nutrition, primary and secondary education, watershed, solar electrification, agricultural practices, SHGs and market linkages can be supported through CSR)
 - Cannot promise yet, but I will check if Tata Capital can be the host company (we are adopting a 1000+ha area for watershed and agricultural practices which is a 3-4 year project. The other participants can collaborate for supporting the other thrust areas)

Roundtable Process

- Welcome & Introducing the concept and the host companies
 - Welcome by Team Sweden
 - Karon to introduce the RISE concept for collaboration
 - The host companies to explain about the area and the project to the groups
- Open for discussion –
 - Members to discuss/question/seek clarification on the model – we can prepare some leading questions on implementation, formalities (documentation), challenges, decision making, etc.
- Group Discussion - Break into priority geographic locations (based on an initial poll) –
 - Form a geographic location groups and mentors to take these discussion forward and action them (we can help prepare a set of responsibilities for the host and other members to consider collaboration)
 - Seek collaboration support for the host project and initiate several discussion on existing member projects (in priority locations) to take collaborations forward simultaneously
- Closure by the group mentors (30 mins)

- Followed by networking over Fika

Study Tour

An industry visit for the Alumni members of the Swedish Institute Management Programme. This will be an indepth, on-field experience of Sandvik (a Swedish Company) and Thermax (an Indian Company) who are well known for their Business Sustainability and Corporate Social Responsibility initiatives.

A full day event post the RISE Summit, there will be a Fika session at the end of day for informal networking with local Swedish companies and other stakeholders.
